## What is GASP?

GASP (Groups Against the Stadium Proposals) was formed when people from several residents' associations, sports clubs, conservation groups and parish councils realised others felt the same anger that these stadium proposals were being pushed through without proper consultation or justification for doing so.

## GASP's objections include:

- Building over Green Belt land at Booker and selling it off to developers to pay for a new stadium
- The committing of **£750,000 of tax-payers' money** to researching this scheme when there wasn't even a business plan
- The waste of **£476,000 to date of tax-payers' money** on dubious research and consultations. The disregard of concerns about the impact on communities local to the airfield
- Misleading the public to believe there would be 'community benefits' to the scheme when the only benefits are to private businesses

## Why the demo?

The White Elephant Parade was conceived as a way to send a signal to the Council's new Cabinet ahead of their crunch meeting on 18 July when they'll discuss the business case for the stadium. The message is that **many people feel that pursuing this development at Booker is wrong and it should stop.**

## What's the plan?

**Assemble by the watermill at The Rye around 2pm, the parade will leave at 2.30pm,** flow under the underpass, past the Council offices and along the High Street to end up at Frogmore. Here there will be a couple of short speeches to round off the event.
